CELEBRATING FREEDOM!

Happy birthday to the United States of America this month, and also to the NGPA, as we continue to remember and celebrate our 25 years of existence. Reflecting back on the U.S. history of how far aviation and equal rights to the LGBT community have come, I'm so thankful I've lived to see so many of these milestones. I recall just after high school, many people within the LGBT community stated we would never see equal marriage laws passed, or open military service men and women in our lifetime. When I started flight training, I still needed to do NDB approaches to complete my check ride. Glass cockpits didn't exist in flight training. Today, flight schools have all-glass cockpit fleets, and commercial airliners can fly from Dallas non-stop to Sydney, recording the longest non-stop flight on the world's largest passenger aircraft. In my very short life of 28 years, I've seen the don't ask don't tell policy implemented and repealed. I've stood in the capital in St. Paul, MN and Honolulu, HI, when both states passed equal marriage laws. I've now seen the NGPA grow nearly 150% in just 12-18 months. We have gone from one airline

recruiting at an event to 22 airlines and growing for 2016. We signed our first University flight school sponsorship in 2015 and we're already renewing it for 2016. We have also recorded our largest corporate sponsorship support to date.

There are so many LGBT aviation pilots, mechanics, flight attendants, customer service reps, etc., looking for a place to call home. As most of us call the U.S.A home, and even more, the NGPA, reach out a hand, and invite them to join the NGPA today.

Our membership committee kicked off in June with our membership drive. You have an opportunity to win some great prizes for your hard work towards building the NGPA.

Our Cape Cod Classic is right around the corner, so be sure to watch for updates on the website, FB, Twitter and emails. 


