

30 pilots and their spouses participated in one of the most electrifying and positive gay pride events we have ever witnessed. Most of us dressed in our company uniforms, without any pride mementos detracting from the uniform. Half the pilots wore pink ties in support of National Breast Cancer Month. We truly stood out as a very unique group of professionals. The students from ERAU represented their generation well, and were very active in all aspects of the parade. For most of them, it was their first Pride parade, and they were marching in it, not just witnessing it! One student described it as "intoxicating".

As we rounded each corner of the parade route, we were met with expressions of shock and silence followed by thundering applause, fist bumps, thumbs-up, and "hey, there are gay pilots!" We were probably the most unexpected group of participants the crowd has ever seen! The expressions on their faces and the inspirational looks from the younger kids lining the parade route were priceless - not because we are gay, but because we are pilots. On more than one occasion we heard bystanders rush up and say "Hey, I'm with United", or

"I'm with JetBlue", which electrified our energy in so many ways.

At this juncture I think NGPA's participation in our Come Out With Pride probably set the bar for future participation and will result in stiff competition for next year's event. We were the only group dressed in ties and exhibited the highest level of professionalism the organizers and participants have ever seen.


NGPA-GO members will continue to represent our profession in the highest, most positive light possible all while upholding NGPA's core values.



As always, we look forward to reporting back to you next month with the highlights and are looking forward to a productive time together in Dallas.

# DELTA AIRLINES SCHOLARSHIP

Requirements, Eligibility, and Application Procedure

To be eligible for an NGPA Education Fund Scholarship, an individual must:

- Be enrolled in a 4-year U.S. accredited college or university;
- Be seeking to develop professional aviation skills and ratings beyond their private & instrument pilot certificate;
- Be at least 18 years of age at the date of application; and
- Have earned at least a private and instrument pilot certificate.



Scholarship funds may be used to pay for:

- Advanced flight training (e.g., multi-engine, commercial, instructor, or ATP);
- Tuition and fees, within a flight education program at an accredited college or university, which cover the cost of advanced flight training.

Funds may not be applied towards a sport, recreational or private pilot certificate.

Please check our website, FaceBook page, and your email on November 1, 2015 for a link to the online application to apply for the scholarship. This new process for applying electronically will ensure efficiency for the applicant and the scholarship selection committee. Should you have any questions about this process once it opens, please don't hesitate to contact us.

Please share this great news with your friends and join me in thanking Delta Air Lines for this amazing opportunity for us to continue to do good for the NGPA and the aviation community.

If you were a recipient of an NGPA scholarship in 2015, you are NOT eligible for the 2015 Delta Air Lines/NGPA Scholarship. You may apply for the 2016 application opening early next year.




## NEW NGPA WEBSITE
